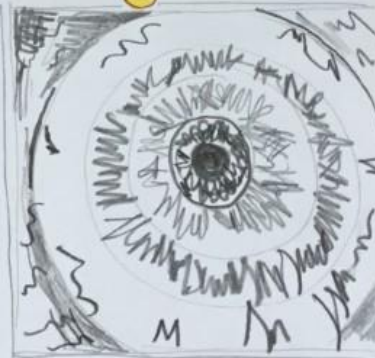

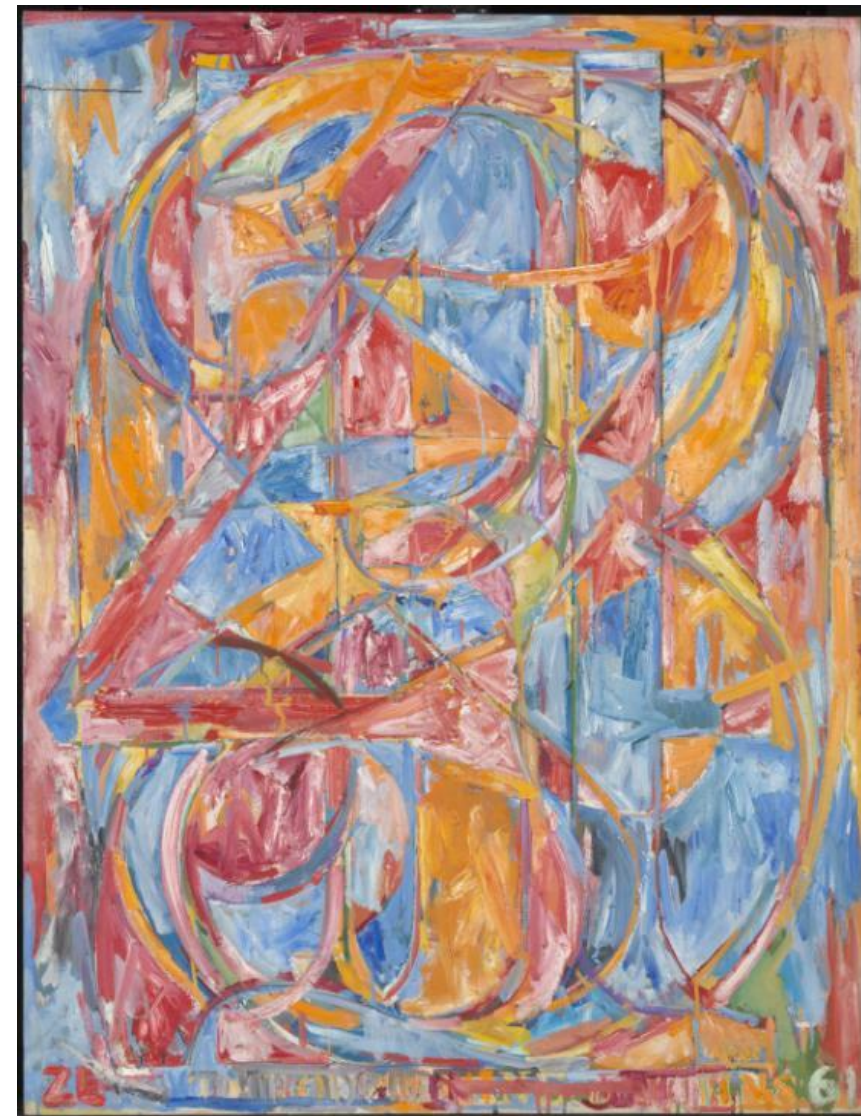

Reasons to be more donkey



Shocks is amazingly loyal to the staff that care for him.

1. Donkeys are loyal to their herd and their individual friends within the herd, offering each other comfort and companionship. Their friendships can last a lifetime. Their loyalty extends to humans and to other species of animal, too. In rural areas, a guard donkey's bray is often the farmer's first warning that something is wrong.

2. Donkeys co-exist with their environment. They have an inbuilt understanding of which plants are good and bad to eat. They are naturally inclined to forage over large distances, rather than strip one area bare. In desert lands, wild donkeys use their hooves to dig in the dirt to access groundwater, creating little wells that help sustain smaller animals.

3. Donkeys come in all shapes and sizes. There are 186 breeds of donkey, from miniature Mediterraneans at 31 inches to huge Poitou's at 63 inches. They come in all coat types and colours. They each have an individual personality, just like humans.

4. Donkeys live in the moment. They have an extraordinary ability to 'tune in' to the feelings of those around them and offer support and unconditional love. It's proven that being in their company helps regulate the human heartbeat.

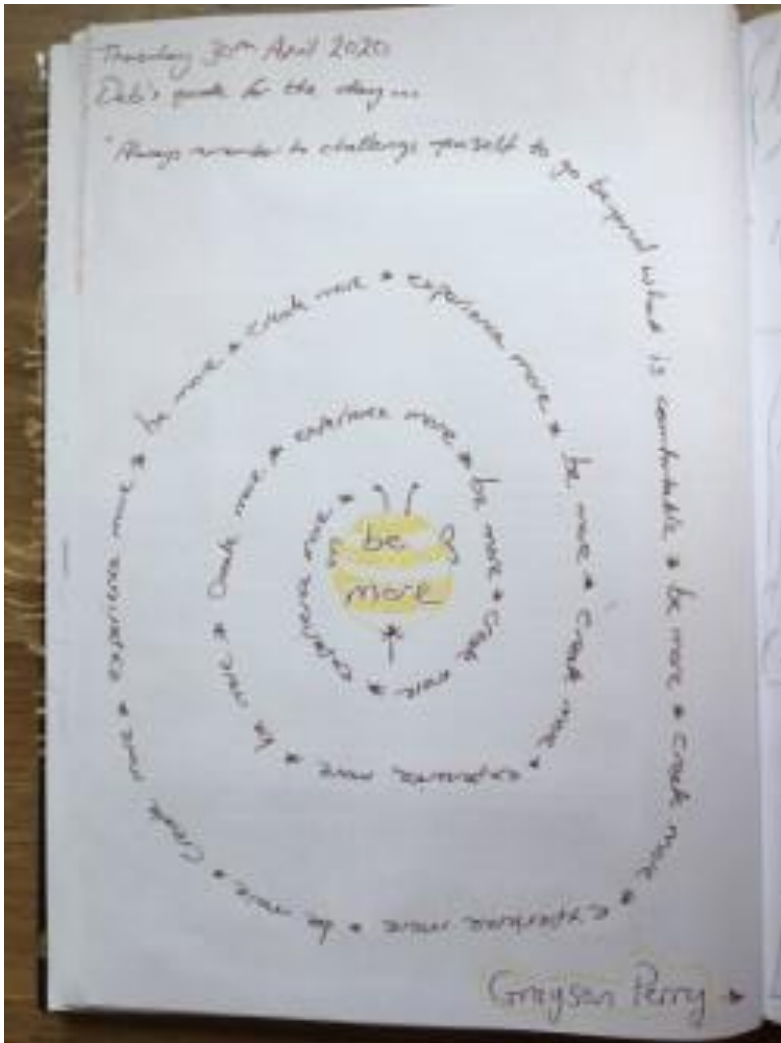
