

Planting seeds



Equipment needed

Seed tray, seeds, watering can, tamper, compost, label and pen.



Read the instruction on the packet of seeds
as to when the best time to sew the seeds

Step 1. Fill the tray with compost.



Step 2. Level off the compost using the tamper or a piece of wood.



Step 3. Press down the compost very gentle with the tamper. If you haven't got a tamper you can use another tray. Don't press too hard or the new plants will have no room for its roots to grow and for the water.



Step 4. Gentle sprinkle the seeds evenly over the compost.



Step 5. Sprinkle a light covering of compost over the seeds so they are all covered. Do not fill the tray to high else when watering it will go over the edge and not to the seeds.



Step 6. Write the label and date it on the back when they were planted. Place the label in the tray at the edge with the name of the seeds facing in towards the compost and seeds.



Step 7. Water and keep them in a green house or a warm place indoors and wait for them to grow.
