What to do today

Parents/Carers- If you look at the activities below I have tried to include something for every learner in my class. Some activities are practical with a sensory element, some require pupils to write and some pupils will need to use communicate in print symbols to write their sentences.

1. Listen to the story Dear Zoo told by Ciara (find story on the Chadsgrove website in Reading folder).

2. Respond to the story

- Draw a picture to describe the sentences
- Use the communicate in print symbols to write your sentence
- Label the animals
- Use salt dough or playdough to make an animal foot print
- Make a finger puppet
