## **School Health Nursing Team**

Hello and welcome from the School Health Nursing team.

We as School Health Nurses are registered nurses who have undertaken specialist training in public health for children, young people, and families. All children who attend Worcestershire schools have a named School Health Nurse who offers a confidential service and provides support and advice to children, young people, and their families.

The team are supported by Health Care Support Workers who aid the delivery of the service. They work with local communities, families, and individual children in different settings to provide a link between school, home, and community, promoting the safeguarding and wellbeing of children and young people.

The team also utilises a digital system known as SchoolScreener to carry out:

Health needs assessment questionnaires for children in reception, year 6 and year 9 children SchoolScreener



- Hearing screening for reception children
- Height and weight measurements to promote healthier lifestyles under the National Child Measurement programme (NCMP)

SchoolScreener immediately automates results, allowing the team to review answers about your child as soon as they have been submitted. This helps to ensure that any concerns are identified early, and any additional support is available straightaway.

We are aiming to begin the health needs assessment questionnaire for Year 9 children from September 2023. Your child will be able to complete this online at school, supported by the School Health Nurse. Questions covering topics relating to:

- General health
- Lifestyle
- Aspiration

- Emotional health
- Bullying

When your child starts school, you will be issued with a letter containing a 'unique link' to register for a SchoolScreener account. Please wait for this link from your child's school before attempting to set up your account. The SchoolScreener portal is where you will then be able to access the results of your child's school aged hearing screen and their height and weight details in relation to the NCMP. Please wait for the link from your child's school and then set up your account.
