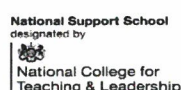
We would like to invite you to send in Christmas gifts for the charity to distribute to those most in need. Please see the attached flyer for further information.

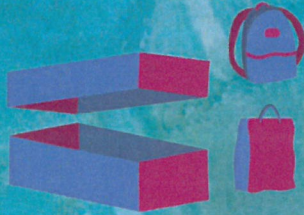
We hope that you will consider joining us in collecting for this worthy cause.

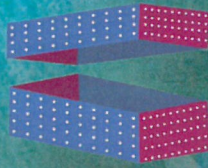


MIGRANT HELP SHOEBOX APPEAL

Fill it with useful gifts

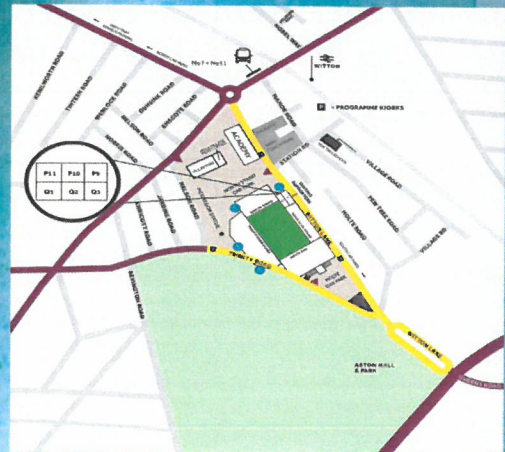
If you don't have a box, a gift bag rucksack is also ok to use
