



Sunny day challenge!



It is a beautiful day today, if you have access to some outdoor space such as a garden or patio, why not take some of your learning outside today.



Using water and a paintbrush is a great way to have some mess free mark making outside!



Colours are great to encourage children to respond to questions! "Can you find a red flower?" or "what colour is this flower?"



Could you work together to collect items to make an outdoor reading space?



How about a scavenger hunt to find different things?

Cut the bottom of the water bottle off. Next slide the sock over the bottom of the bottle. Use colorful duct tape or a rubber band to secure



Add some color to the bubble snakes with food coloring. Drop the food coloring onto the sock covered end. Messy but FUN!



Pour some dish soap into a shallow container with a little bit of water and gently mix. Dip the sock covered bubble blower in and blow!



Adult to set task up by cutting the bottom off a bottle and ensuring no sharp edges and attaching a sock, then using water and washing up liquid you can blow bubble snakes for the children! This is a fun attention and listening activity as well as communication. Encourage the children to request "more" during the task. Will the initiate to request if you dont encourage them? If your child uses PECs, they have a bubble symbol inside they could use for this task.

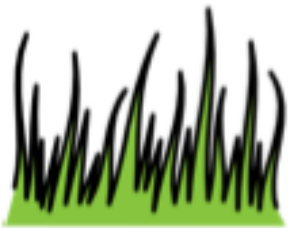
