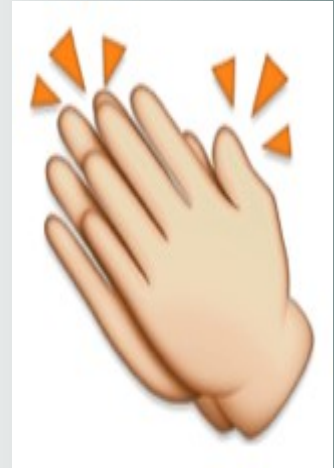


# Link News Letter

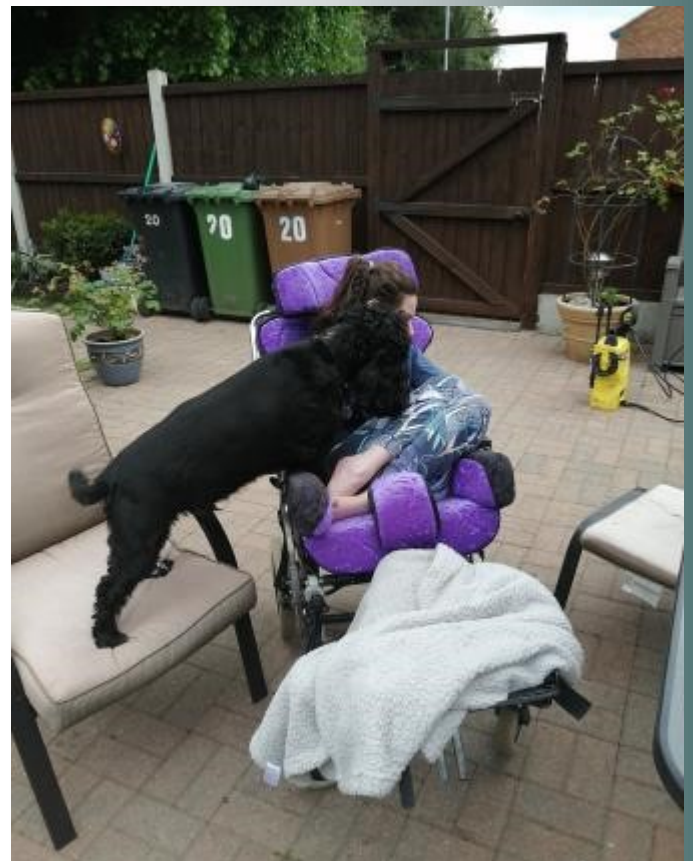

Jess has also been setting up a 'McDonalds' in her house! That's a really good idea! It looks like you even made the bags for the fries! Who was first in the queue

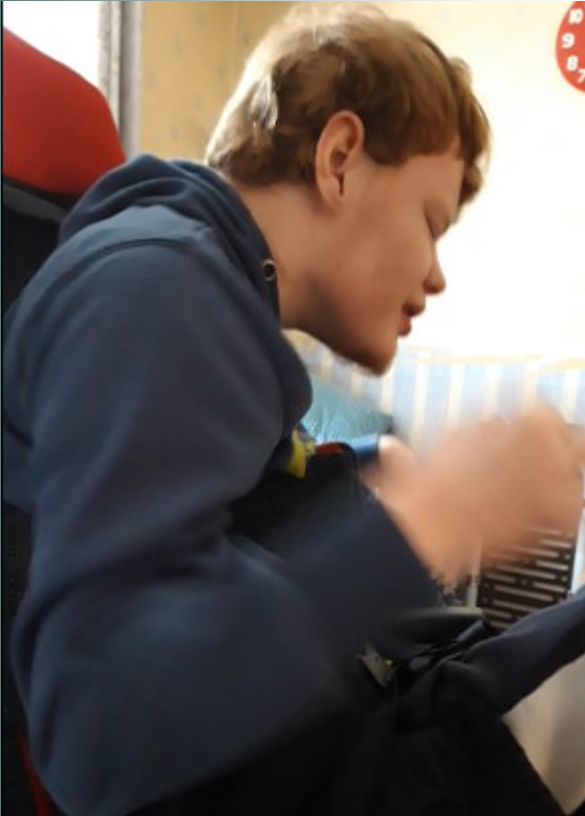
to get their order?

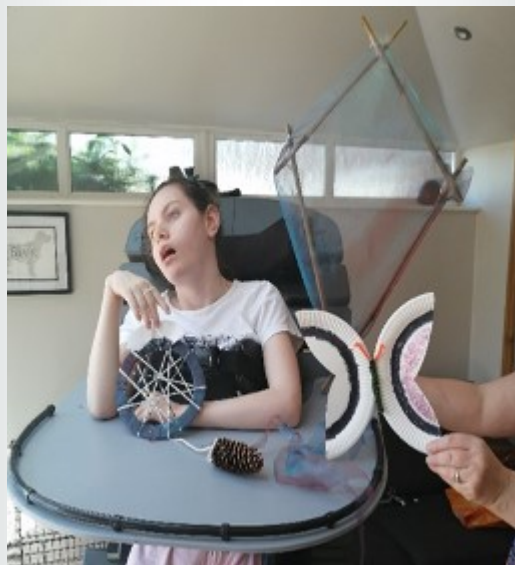
